			<p>Mr Stephen McGowan, Messrs TLT LLP was present by video conference representing the applicant, Mr White, Director, was in attendance within the Council Chambers and Mr Brysland, Director and Mr Adam Gillespie, designated premises manager also attending by video conference.</p> <p>Ms Sinclair proposed that the applications in items 1 and 2 be considered jointly as the terms are similar. Following agreement of the Chair and the applicant's representative, Ms Sinclair advised that the applications are outwith the Board's Festive Season Policy and that Police Scotland had submitted an objection to the applications. Ms Sinclair read the contents of the objections to the Board, copies of which were circulated to Members.</p> <p>Inspector Christie confirmed the reasons for the Police Scotland objection and Ms Dillon provided comments to the Board.</p> <p>Mr McGowan addressed the Board clarifying that his submissions refer to both premises. He advised that the hours applied for are similar to those that the Board granted in 2019. He spoke on the comments referred to by the Chief Superintendent and the difficulties that the licence holder has had to overcome due to the public health pandemic. Mr McGowan provided information in terms of the running of the events, the staff and security that will be in place.</p> <p>There followed discussion, questions and answers between all parties.</p> <p>After a private discussion of Members, upon returning to the public session, Councillor Crowther moved grant of the applications with the assurance that the appropriate staff and SIA Stewards will be appointed accordingly, as an amendment, Councillor Curley moved refusal of the applications. On a vote, two Members (Councillors Curley and Ahlfeld) voted for the amendment and three Members (Councillors Crowther, McEleny and Moran) voted for the motion which was declared carried.</p> <p>Mr McGowan confirmed acceptance of the Condition and that staffing numbers will be based on a Risk Assessment being undertaken for each event.</p>
