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Community Link Workers



Community Link Workers (CLW) support patients with non-medical issues affecting overall physical and emotional wellbeing. This is known as social prescribing.

Community Link Workers guide and refer patients to services, resources, advice and support for a variety of concerns including:

- Financial worries
- Mental health concerns
- Physical activity (exercise)
- Emotional support
- Housing matters



CLW work closely and in partnership with health, social care, voluntary and third sector organisations to offer patients a range of options to best suit their needs.



Referrals can be made by Nurses Receptionists, Physiotherapists, and Pharmacists.

Maintaining confidentiality at all times, Community Link Workers are highly skilled and trained to deliver a professional service similar to the GP Practice team.

A GP appointment is not necessary for a referral to the Community Link Worker team.
