Community Treatment & Care (CTAC)



Community Treatment & Care (CTAC) is a long-standing nurse-led service formally known as Treatment Rooms.

Working alongside GPs, the CTAC team provide specialist care in Health Centres and GP Practices.

Patients benefit from access to expertly trained nursing staff at CTAC settings for assessment and treatment in addition to GP Practice care.

Should patients require to visit one of our centres, they are located at:

Greenock, Gourock and Port Glasgow Health Centres. The GP Practice will make a referral to the CTAC service.



Treatment & Care includes:

- Blood pressure, blood glucose, blood samples
- Pulse and body temperature
- Ear Care for blocked ears (wax)
- Removal of stitches and staples
- Wound, leg ulcer, dressing care
- Medication administration: i.e injections
- Catheter care

The Community Treatment & Care (CTAC) Team work alongside GPs, ensuring patients receive the right care in the right place.
