NOTICE UNDER SECTION 104 OF THE COMMUNITY EMPOWERMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 2015

Proposed Lease of 8 John Wood Street, Port Glasgow

Notice is hereby given in terms of Section 104 of the Community Empowerment (Scotland) Act 2015 that the Inverclyde Council, constituted under the Local Government etc. (Scotland) Act 1994 and having its main office at Municipal Buildings, Clyde Square, Greenock (“**the Council**”) intends to grant of a lease of the premises forming part of the common good, namely 8 John Wood Street, Port Glasgow, (“**the Property**”), part of the common good.

The Council intends to grant a lease of the Property on the following terms:

- the tenant will be Port Glasgow Retail Ltd (or such alternative company as those proposing to operate that company may propose);
- the start date is to be agreed, but anticipated as soon as reasonably practicable;
- the lease will be a one year annual missive of let;
- the Property will be used by the Tenant as a retail pop up shop;
- for an open market rent; and
- on normal commercial full repairing and insuring terms.

If, following consideration of any representations received in this consultation, the Council decides to proceed with the proposal, the lease will be granted as soon as reasonably practicable.
