- In the interests of amenity as the woodland is a dominant feature and it can be seen from many parts, especially the Kilmacolm Road and Auchenbothie Road and it presents a pleasing relief to the landscape
- If the woodland were to be felled, it would remove the only group of dominant and pleasant trees within an area of 330 acres
- The loss of the woodland environment involved in clear felling would lead to a rapid degradation of the site, which rough grazing would not improve and any subsequent attempts at afforestation would be very difficult
- From the wildlife point of view, the loss of the site would be considerable as its extent is sufficient to provide habitats for a variety of both mammals and birds.
