1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of this report is to advise the Inverclyde Integration Joint Board ("IJB") of a number of recent membership changes.

2.0 SUMMARY

- 2.1 The Public Bodies (Joint Working) (Integration Joint Boards) (Scotland) Order 2014 sets out the arrangements for the membership of all Integration Joint Boards.
- 2.2 Since its last meeting, there have been some changes to the non-voting membership of the IJB together with some changes to the voting and non-voting membership of the IJB Audit Committee.
- 2.3 This reports sets out the revised membership arrangements for both the IJB and the IJB Audit Committee.

3.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

- 3.1 It is recommended that the Inverclyde Integration Joint Board:-
 - (1) notes the appointment by Greater Glasgow and Clyde NHS Board of Deirdre McCormick as the Professional Nurse Advisor non-voting member of the Inverclyde Integration Joint Board;
 - (2) notes that Drew White has been confirmed as the proxy member for Robyn Garcha, Council Staff Representative, non-voting member for meetings of the Integration Joint Board;
 - (3) notes that Inverclyde Council appointed Councillor Jim Clocherty as the Vice-Chair of the Inverclyde Integration Joint Board at its meeting on 29 June 2017;
 - (4) notes the resignation of Robyn Garcha as a non-voting member of the Inverclyde Integration Joint Board Audit Committee;
 - (5) appoints a non-voting member to serve on the Inverclyde Integration Joint Board Audit Committee, with the nomination and appointment being made at the meeting; and
 - (6) notes the appointment of Dr Donald Lyons as voting member of the Inverclyde Integration Joint Board Audit Committee to replace Dorothy McErlean.

4.0 BACKGROUND

- 4.1 The Public Bodies (Joint Working) (Integration Joint Boards) (Scotland) Order 2014 ("the Order") sets out the arrangements for the membership of all Integration Joint Boards. As a minimum this must comprise:
 - voting members appointed by Greater Glasgow and Clyde NHS Board and Inverclyde Council;
 - non-voting members who are holders of key posts within either the NHS Board or Inverclyde Council; and
 - representatives of groups who have an interest in the IJB.

5.0 NON VOTING MEMBERSHIP

- 5.1 Susan O'Rourke, the Professional Nurse Advisor (non-voting member) left her post on 31 August 2017. This membership role will now be filled by Deirdre McCormick, who has been appointed by Greater Glasgow and Clyde NHS Board in terms of Regulation 3(2) of the Order.
- 5.2 Robyn Garcha, the Council Staff Representative (non-voting member) has confirmed that her named proxy to cover attendance at IJB meetings for period of extended absence is Drew White.

6.0 VOTING MEMBERSHIP

6.1 Inverclyde Council confirmed the appointment of Jim Clocherty as Vice-Chair of the IJB at its meeting of 29 June 2017.

7.0 IJB AUDIT COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP

- 7.1 The IJB agreed the revised membership of the IJB Audit Committee on 6 June 2017. Since then, Robyn Garcha has intimated her resignation as a non-voting member of the IJB Audit Committee.
- 7.2 It is therefore necessary for the IJB to appoint a new non-voting member to the IJB Audit Committee to fill this vacancy.
- 7.3 Dorothy McErlean has also advised that she is stepping down as a voting member of the IJB Audit Committee and that Dr Donald Lyons will take her place.

8.0 PROPOSALS

8.1 It is proposed that the IJB notes the revised IJB membership arrangements as set out in Appendix 1, the revised IJB Audit Committee membership arrangements as set out in Appendix 2 and appoints a new non-voting member of the IJB Audit Committee.
