## 1.0 PURPOSE

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to give details of applications received for consideration for funding from the Grants to Voluntary Organisations Budget in 2018/19.

## 2.0 SUMMARY

- 2.1 The budget for the Grants to Voluntary Organisations Fund for 2018/19 is £244,160.
- 2.2 At the Education & Communities Committee it was agreed that £18,600 of the core budget is allocated to pay commercial rents of four third sector organisations:
- Samaritans
  - Youth Connections
  - Murdieston Dam Boat Club
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Gourock Scouts (6<sup>th</sup> Greenock & District) - Drumshantie Road Scout Hall
- £30,000 has also been approved for summer play schemes at the following venues:
- Branchton Community Centre
  - Craigend Resource Centre
  - Auchmountain Community Centre
  - Youth Connections
  - Inverkip Community Centre (via Inverclyde Leisure)
  - Boglestone Community Centre (via Inverclyde Leisure)
- 2.3 In Round 1 of GTVO 2018/19, Committee approved one-off awards totalling £193,334.88.
- 2.4 In the financial year 2017/18 awards were approved for Gourock Horticultural Society (£1,000) and REACH for Autism (£12,000). As the Conditions of Grant could not be met then funds amounting to £13,000 have been released back into the GTVO budget for 2018/19.
- 2.5 As there is an underspend of £8,008 within the Under 19's Sports budget for 2018/19, this amount is being utilised in the allocation of funds for GTVO applications Round 2, 2018/19.
- 2.6 It is requested that Finance arrange for a virement of £8,008 from Under 19s Sports Grants to Grants to Voluntary Organisations.
- 2.7 Taking the above into account, the balance available for new one-off applications is £23,233.12.

2.8 In total, 44 one off grant applications have been received.

12 applications were already in receipt of funding from the GTVO 2018/19 budget. These applicants have been notified that their application will automatically be deferred until Round 1, 2019/20.

This leaves a balance of 32 one off applications with the total sum requested being £163,736.36. Details of the grant applications received are given in Appendix A.

To assist the Grants Sub-Committee, Officers have proposed indicative awards within the budget available. These reflect previous awards made to applicants or similar projects approved by the Sub-Committee. These recommendations are given in Appendix B – Private Paper.

Officer recommendations currently total £23,232, leaving a balance of £1.12.

Members are invited to determine the final grants awarded to each application as detailed in the appendices, having regard to Officer's recommendations and the total funds available.

### **3.0 RECOMMENDATIONS**

3.1 It is recommended that the Grants Sub-Committee determine the level of funding to be allocated to the organisations in Appendix A.
