### **THE CAMPAIGN TO SAVE INCHGREEN DRY DOCK**

#### *Sub group draft motion*

The campaign to save Inchgreen dry dock would propose that Inverclyde Council's Environment and Regeneration Committee creates a sub group to focus on the regeneration of our coastal industrial land and facilities. The sub group should be titled “ The regeneration of coastal industrial land and facilities group”.
