486 “Inspiring Inverclyde”: A Community Plan for Inverclyde 2008 - 2018 486

There was submitted a report by the Corporate Director Improvement & Performance appending the new Inverclyde Alliance Community Plan 2008 - 2018, “Inspiring Inverclyde”, which had been agreed by the Inverclyde Alliance Board on 20 April 2008.

Decided:

- (1) that the Council endorse “Inspiring Inverclyde”, the Inverclyde Alliance Community Plan 2008 - 2018, as set out in the appendix to the report;
- (2) that the final version of the plan be posted on the Council’s website and a summary document be produced and made available to stakeholders; and
- (3) that it be remitted to officers to put in place the appropriate arrangements to support the delivery of the Single Outcome Agreement and the Community Plan.

487 Inverclyde Single Outcome Agreement 487

There was submitted a report by the Corporate Director Environment & Community Protection appending the final Single Outcome Agreement (SOA) for submission to the Scottish Government.

Decided:

- (1) that the Council endorse the revised Single Outcome Agreement set out in the appendix to the report;
- (2) that agreement be given to move forward with Inverclyde Alliance partners to develop, by the end of March 2009, a full partnership Single Outcome Agreement as required by the Scottish Government;
- (3) that the Single Outcome Agreement be posted on the Council’s website; and
- (4) that it be remitted to officers to put in place the appropriate arrangements to support the delivery of the Single Outcome Agreement and the Community Plan.
