Subject: Provision of Street Name - Maukinhill

1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 The Committee is requested to assign a street name for a new cul-de-sac within the Maukinhill Regeneration Project, Greenock.

2.0 SUMMARY

2.1 I would advise that the development is part of the major housing redevelopment in this area and, while the main body of housing utilises existing roads, a new cul-de-sac has been formed off Corlic Street.

2.2 Gryffe Street, a cul-de-sac off Millar Street, has been removed as part of the redevelopment and I would suggest the name "Gryffe Place" could be re-assigned to the new cul-de-sac.

2.3 The developer has consulted the Maukinhill Residents Group and has commented as follows:-

"The residents group request that the street is named after the late former Provost Cathy Allan who resided at 17 Strone Crescent.

I am told that Mrs. Allan was a popular figure who was actively involved and campaigned on behalf of the community over the years. Mrs. Allan was provost in the years 1994-1999.

I trust you will consider the above request positively and look forward to confirmation of the new street name to conclude postal address allocation for Phase 1".

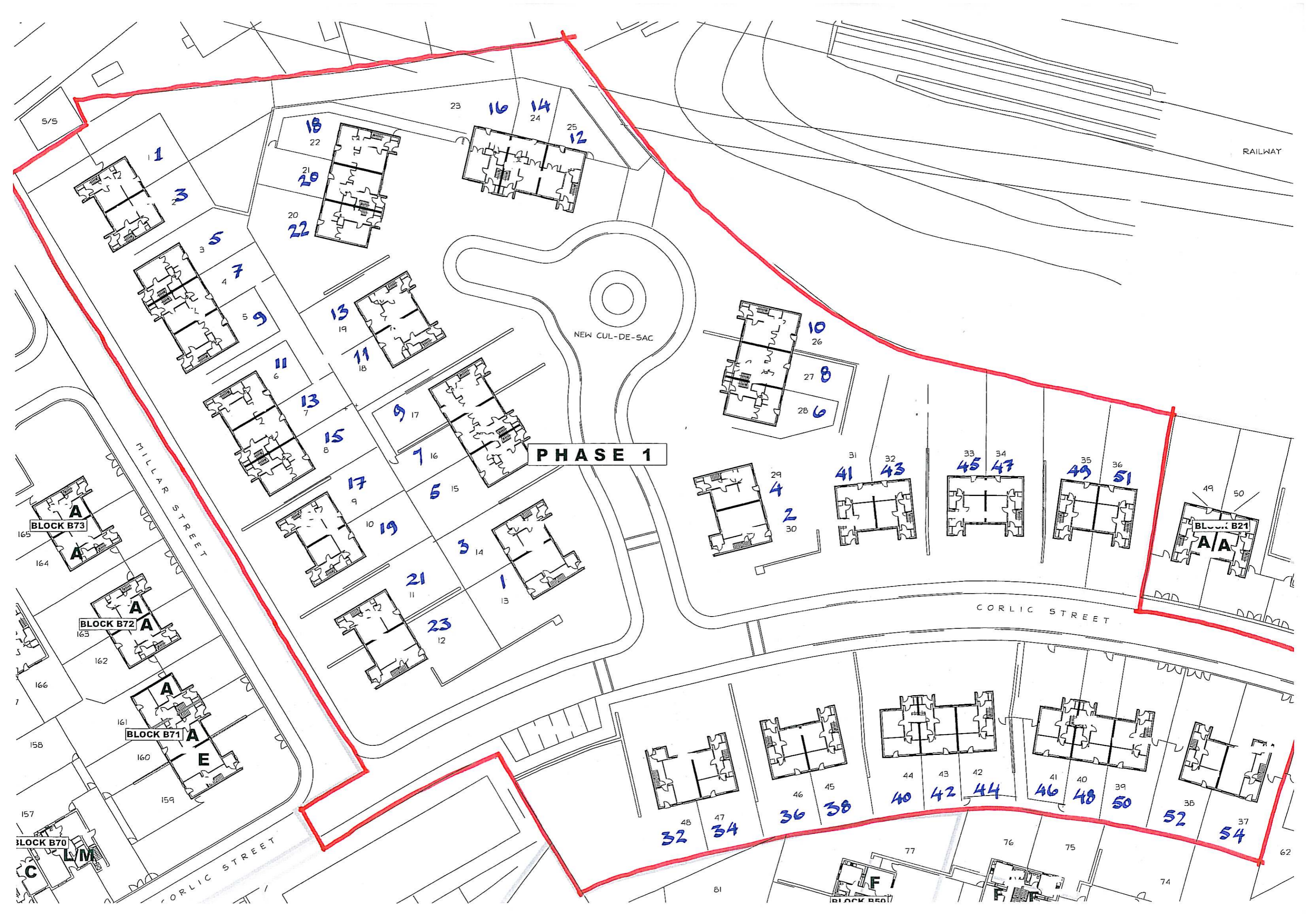
2.4 The Local Members were consulted and indicated that the suggestion from the local community would be acceptable
