Subject: PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER - BELHAVEN

STREET BRIDGE, PORT GLASGOW (7.5 TONNE WEIGHT

**RESTRICTION REVOCATION) ORDER 2009** 

### 1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 Local Authorities are empowered to make Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation and Roads (Scotland) Acts 1984 and under the Council's Scheme of Administration the Head of Environmental Services is responsible for the making, implementation and review of Traffic Management Orders and Traffic Regulation Orders.

#### 2.0 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 Belhaven Street Bridge carries Belhaven Street over the Devol Burn in Port Glasgow. Following structural investigation, a weight restriction of 7.5 Tonnes was imposed on the bridge in 2002.
- 2.2 The existing Traffic Regulation Order in force is "The Inverclyde Council, Belhaven Street Bridge, Port Glasgow (7.5 Tonne Weight Restriction) Order 2002".
- 2.2 The Bridge has been replaced with a new structure and the 7.5 Tonne weight restriction is no longer necessary. Accordingly, it is proposed to revoke the Traffic Regulation Order which imposes the restriction.
- 2.2 The proposals have been advertised in the Greenock Telegraph and full details of the proposals have been made available for public inspection during normal office hours at the offices of the Head of Environmental Services, the Head of Legal & Administration and Greenock Central and Port Glasgow Libraries. A copy of the draft Order is appended hereto for Members' information.

- 2.3 No objections to the proposals have been received.
- 2.4 The Committee is asked to note that, if approved, the Order may not be implemented until the making of the order has been advertised to allow any persons who so wish a period of six weeks to question the validity of the Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

### 3.0 **RECOMMENDATION**

3.1 That the Committee recommend to The Inverclyde Council the making of the Traffic Regulation Order – Belhaven Street Bridge, Port Glasgow (7.5 Tonne Weight Restriction Revocation) 2009 and remit it to the Head of Environmental Services and Head of Legal & Administration to arrange for its implementation.
