Subject:	Transport (Scotland) Act 2005 – Quarterly Indicator Analysis and Fixed Penalty Notices		

1.0 PURPOSE

- 1.1 To provide Committee with an update on Inverclyde Council's performance in relation to the Transport (Scotland) Act 2005 legislation.

2.0 SUMMARY

- 2.1 The introduction of the Transport (Scotland) Act 2005 (T(S)A 2005) was noted by Committee on 1 May 2008.
- 2.2 Road works authorities and statutory undertakers are required to register and close out all works on public roads, footways and footpaths within agreed timescales failing which they may be subject to a Fixed Penalty Notice (FPN).
- 2.3 The Office of the Scottish Road Works Commissioner has prepared a Quarterly Indicator Analysis as per Attachment 1 which details the Council's positive performance in relation to the above legislation.
- 2.4 The Council have issued 111 FPN's to statutory undertakers for failing to comply with the duties imposed on them by the above legislation.

3.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

- 3.1 That the Committee note the Council's positive performance in terms of the above legislation.
- 3.2 That the Committee note the Fixed Penalty Notices that have been issued and the associated income.

4.0 BACKGROUND

- 4.1 As advised to Committee on 1 May 2008 Roads Authorities have an obligation to provide details of all work on public roads, footways and footpaths which are entered in the Scottish Roads Works Register (SRWR). Symology have the current contract to provide the software to store this information and provide interfaces for roads authorities and statutory undertakers to access and input information.
- 4.2 The T(S)A 2005 created new duties for roads authorities. They are required to enter information about all road management and maintenance works undertaken and permissions granted under the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 such as permits for skips, road openings etc. The information includes the extent, start date, and duration of all works with some minor exceptions. Any changes due to bad weather, plant breakdowns etc. must also be reported.
- 4.3 The fundamental purpose of the legislation was to improve the planning, co-ordination and quality of road works in Scotland by both road works authorities (Councils for local roads and Transport Scotland for trunk roads) and statutory undertakers (utilities). The legislation requires road works authorities to use their best endeavours to co-ordinate the execution of works of all kinds in the roads for which they are responsible:
 - a. in the interests of safety
 - b. to minimise the inconvenience to persons using the road (having regard in particular to the needs of people with disability); and
 - c. to protect the structure of the road and the integrity of apparatus within it.
- 4.4 The new legislation places significant obligations on road works authorities (and statutory undertakers) to register all works carried out on roads.
- 4.5 A Scottish Road Works Commissioner was appointed by Scottish Ministers to oversee the provisions of the NRSWA91 and R(S)A84 as extended and amended by T(S)A2005. The Office of the Scottish Road Works Commissioner monitors work on roads to ensure compliance with legislation and has the power to levy penalties on road works authorities and statutory undertakers if they either fail to provide or give incorrect information.
- 4.6 Not all works for roads purposes are undertaken by road works authorities themselves. However, the responsibility for registering works carried out by a third party on behalf of the road works authorities rests with the road works authority. Similarly, a Council may undertake works for another Council or a utility company and, in such cases, the responsibility for registering works lies with that Council or company.
Work carried out on a private road must also be registered by the road works authority.
- 4.7 A Fixed Penalty Notice (FPN) scheme was introduced as part of the T(S) A2005 for those authorities or undertakers who fail to provide or give incorrect information. Inverclyde Council have issued 111 FPN's with an associated income of £7,800. A further 12 FPN's are awaiting assessment by the appropriate Statutory Undertakers with a further associated income of £720.
If a FPN is agreed and is not paid within the period for payment then it remains open to the road works authority to report the offence to the Procurator Fiscal.
- 4.8 Inverclyde Council are one of only three Councils in Scotland who are issuing FPN's. Other Local Authorities issuing FPN's are Argyll & Bute and South Lanarkshire.

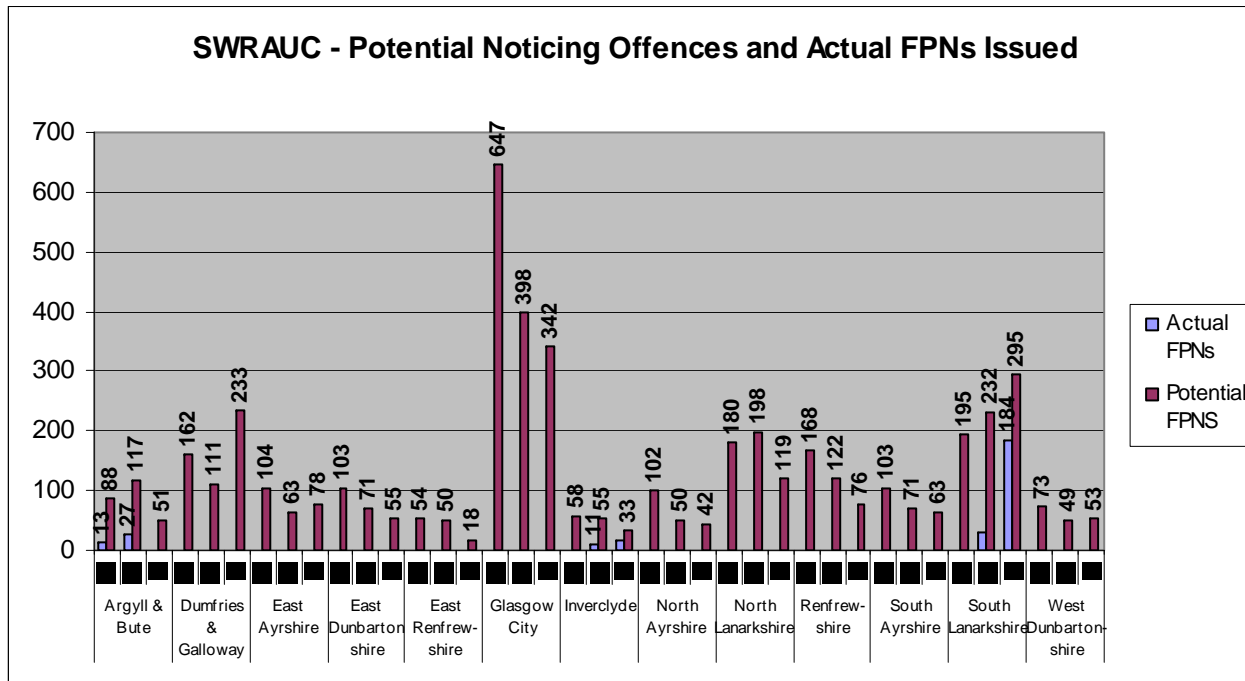

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RWC 1 – Utility Company Potential Noticing Offences & Actual Fixed Penalty Notices Given – The total number of potential noticing offences for each utility company triggered during each quarter compared to the number of FPNs given by roads authorities during this period. The number of withdrawn FPNs during the period is subtracted to give the actual FPN total.



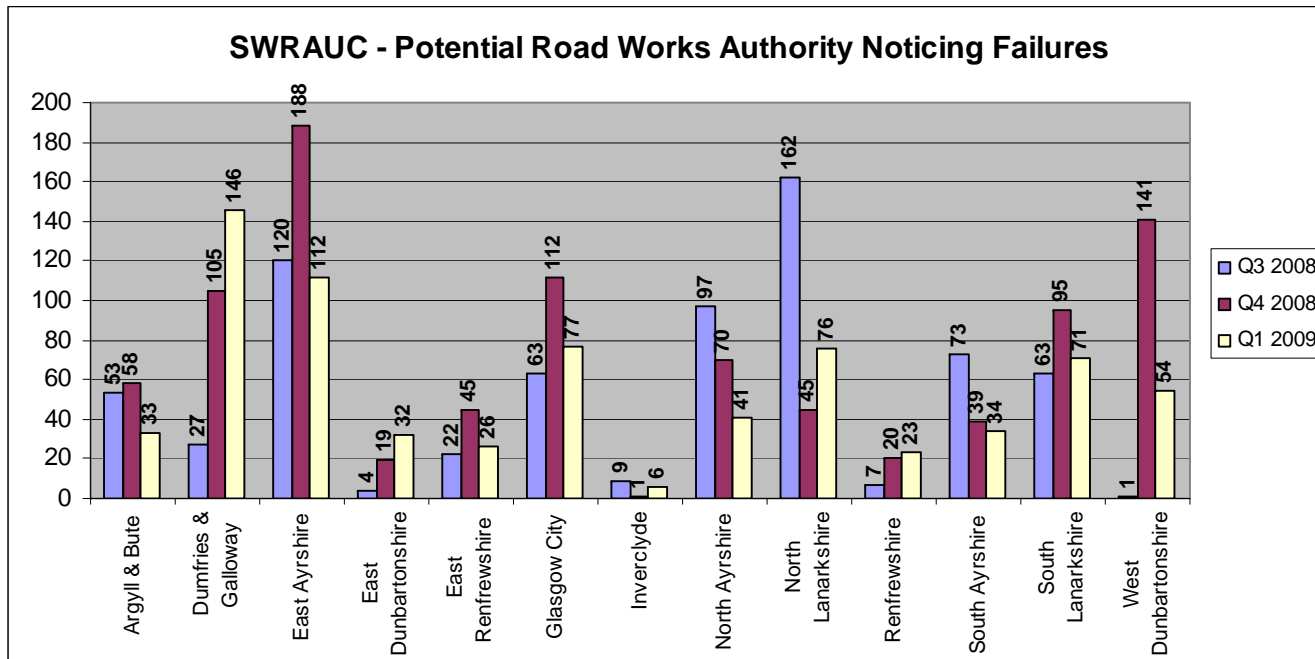
Commissioner’s Commentary

- Glasgow City still appear to have large numbers of potential FPNs being generated in their area.
- Only Argyll & Bute , Inverclyde and South Lanarkshire having been giving FPNs as of Q1 2009. None were issued from Argyll & Bute in Q1.
- The Commissioner would be interested in finding out whether other councils plan to adopt schemes to issue FPNs.
- We are pleased to see the overall numbers of potential FPNs decrease in Q1 and would anticipate that this trend will continue throughout 2009. It is however disappointing to see the number of offences by Scottish Water increase between Q4 and Q1.

RWC 2a – Roads Authority Noticing Failures – The total number of noticing failures by roads authorities. This is broadly similar to the potential noticing offences triggered for utility companies.



Commissioner’s Commentary

- RA’s had very high numbers of potential offences in Q3 and Q4 2008 and although the number of offences decreased slightly in this area in Q1, the results are still disappointing
- It has been clear that some authorities have not been noticing correctly or entering in the actual start notices, which has led to their performance looking even poorer in this area. Some councils are improving here, but it is disappointing to note that Glasgow has a low number of notices for such a large council area.
- The Utilities average for noticing failures is only 16%. We would anticipate that RWAs could achieve similar results but so far only Inverclyde has a low percentage of noticing failures in proportion to their works (7%).

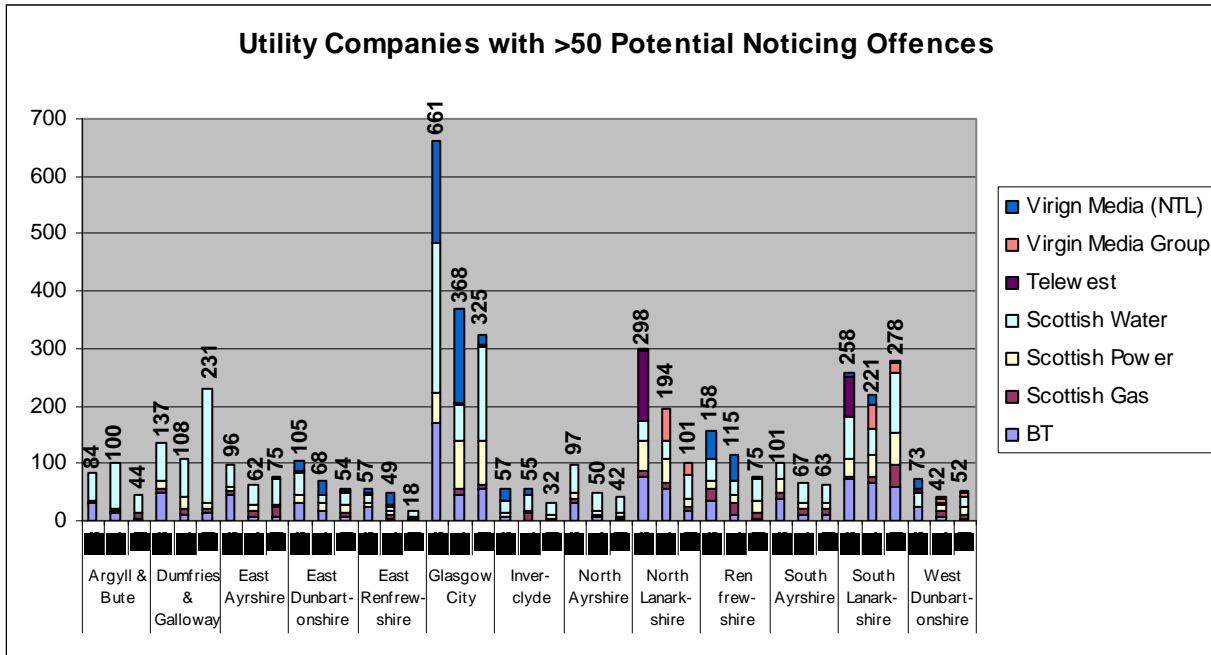

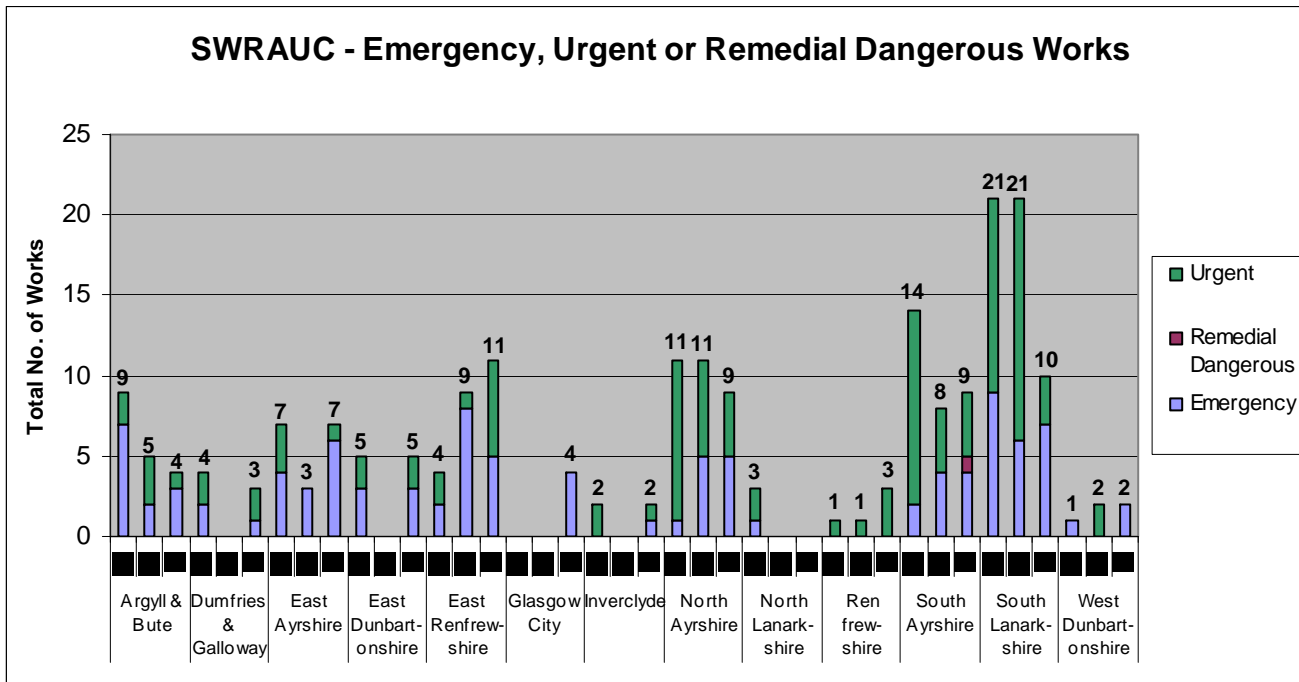

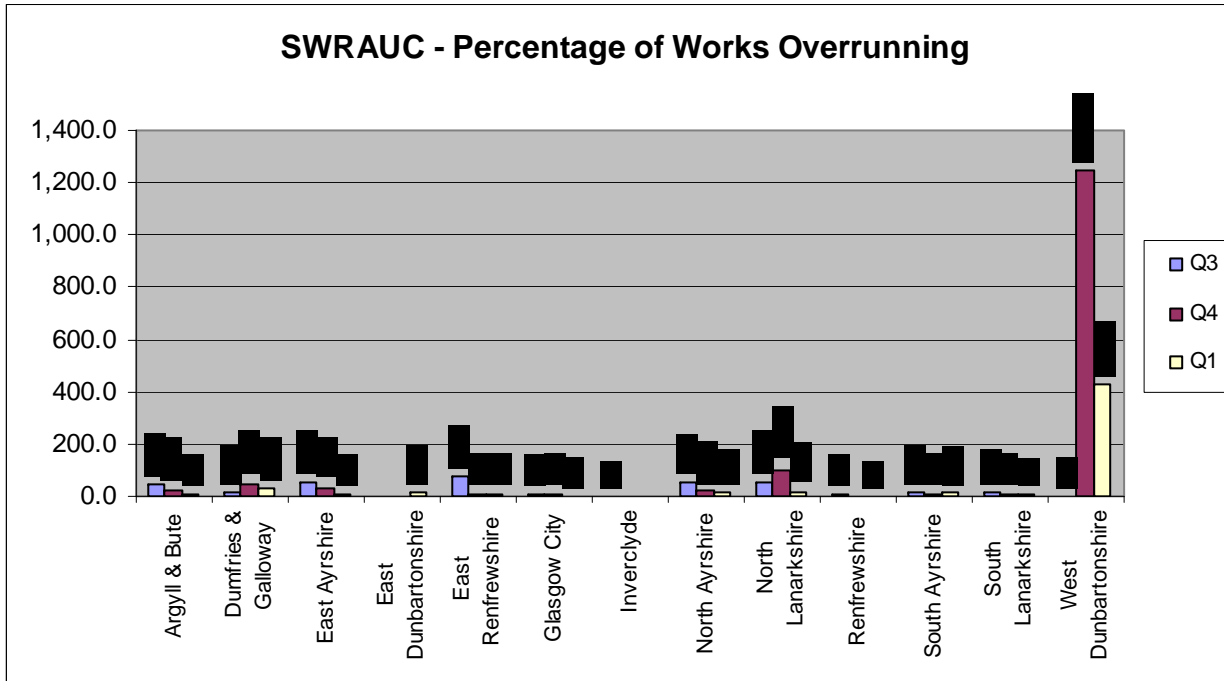
Commissioner's Commentary

Commissioner’s Commentary

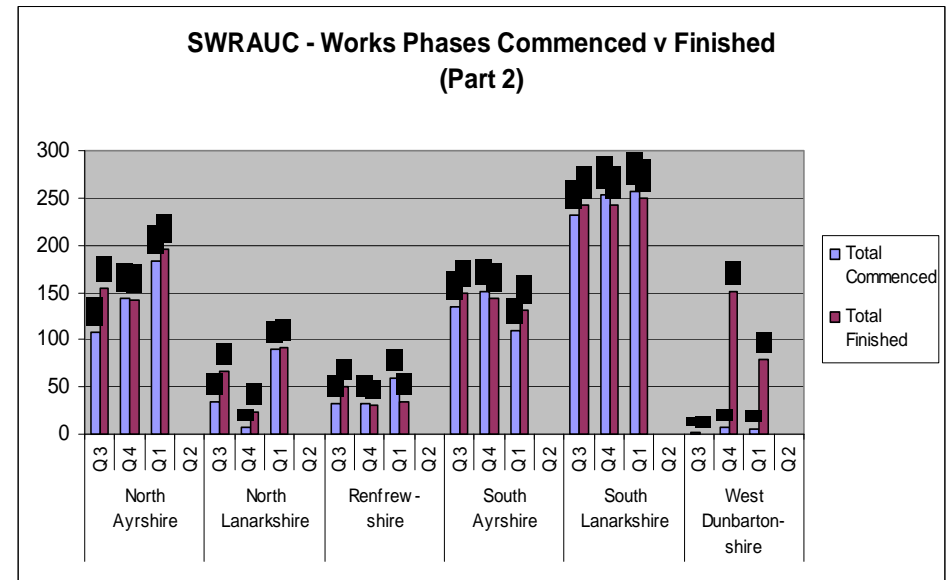
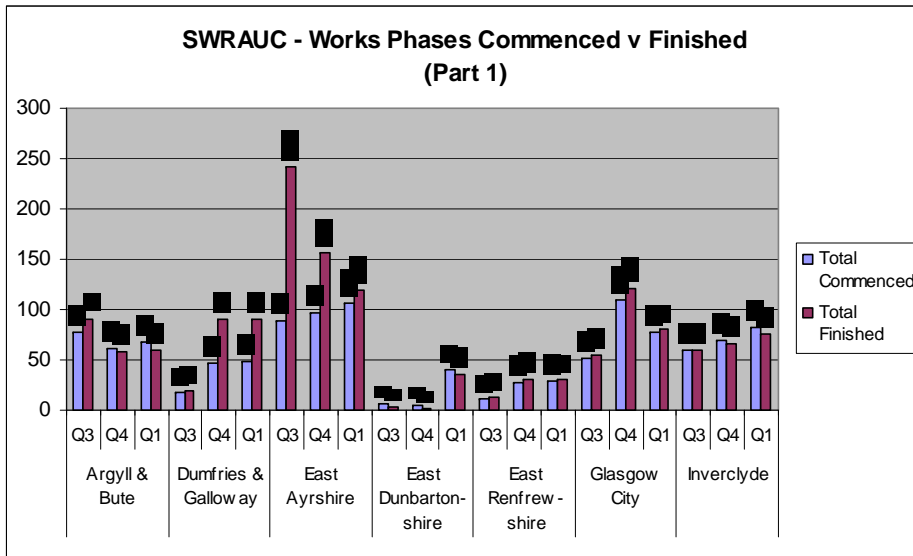
- The number of overrunning works are falling considerably. West Dunbartonshire has skewed the data due to their low numbers of works entered. The overrunning works are a result of previous works in the system or ones that have not been closed off.
- Argyll & Bute, East Ayrshire, Glasgow City, Renfrewshire and South Lanarkshire all report a low percentage of overruns.
- This report needs to be compared with the report setting out the work extensions issued.

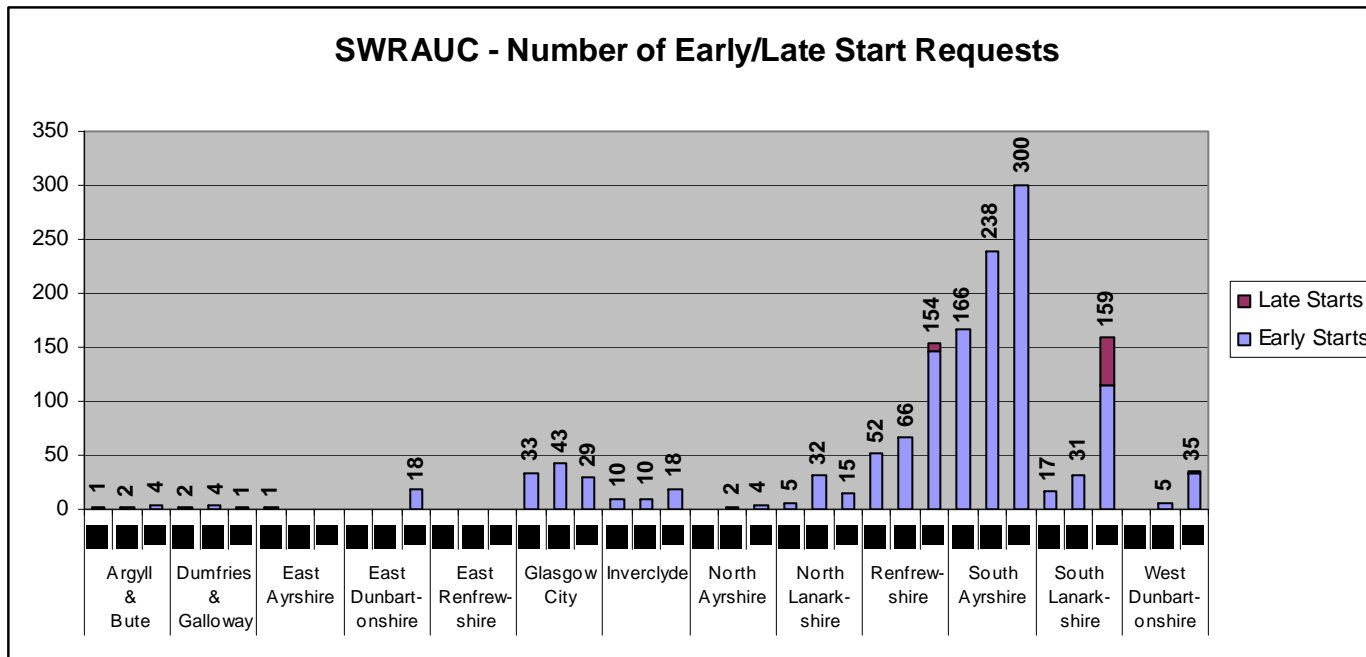
Commissioner’s Commentary

- Whilst the total number of works has increased between Q4 and Q1, there are still a number of councils in this area who do not appear to be noticing correctly. It is encouraging to note that there is fairly even correlation between works closed and works opened in this area.
- West Dunbartonshire is performing poorly as it has recorded 79 works closed compared to 6 started in Q1. They would appear perhaps to have been closing down historical works in Q1. They are also well behind the other councils in the area in recording actual starts.
- If we were to use South Lanarkshire Council as a benchmark, it would suggest that other councils may not be recording all of their works.
