- 2.6 It is also worth noting that Hunterston is jointly recognised along with Inverclyde (waterfront) in the 'National Renewables Infrastructure Plan 2010', as having the potential to provide land for the integrated manufacture and support of off-shore wind energy development. This position has recently been promoted through the 'Inverclyde Renewable Energy Hub 2010' document prepared by the Council in partnership with Clydeport and Riverside Inverclyde.
