## **1.0 PURPOSE**

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to advise the Committee of the Development Plan devised for the CHP in Inverclyde. This will be the basis for the development of the CHCP Directorate Plan over the next six months and will also form the foundation for future integrated plans from April 2011 (The Development Plan will be issued under separate cover).

## **2.0 SUMMARY**

- 2.1 This plan was presented to Committee in May 2010, and although the content has been refined, it still reflects the agreed priorities and outcomes for health and is inclusive of the SOA, JCCP, and the Planning and Policy Frameworks. Key actions for Year 1 and beyond are identified although the 2011 targets will be integrated with those of the Directorate Plan for social work services to produce a plan for the Community Health and Care Partnership.
- 2.2 The Performance Improvement Report will continue to be produced in order that the new CHCP Committee has the necessary information to ensure that we are delivering the outcomes agreed within the plan.

## **3.0 CONSULTATION**

- 3.1 Throughout the summer of 2010 various groups of our key stakeholders including the Public Partnership Forum, Staff Partnership Forum and the Professional Executive Group have considered and informed the content of the plan resulting in the final version signed off by the CHP Committee.

## **4.0 RECOMMENDATIONS**

- 4.1 The Committee is asked to Note the CHP Development Plan 2010 -2013 and recognise that the Plan will be a dynamic working document that will adapt to take account of the pressures, priorities and vision of the emergent CHCP.
