1.0 PURPOSE

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to give details of applications received for consideration of funding from the Grants to Voluntary Organisations Budget in 2010/11

2.0 SUMMARY

- 2.1 The Budget for the Grants to Voluntary Organisations Fund for 2010/11 is £413,780. Following the first round of awards in June of this year, the balance available is currently £113,154.
- 2.2 Details of the grants applications received for Round 2 are given in Appendix A. In total, 77 applications have been received with the total sum requested being £343,147
- 2.3 Further information on each application is available on request and will also be available at the Committee meeting.

After round 1 of the awards, the balance available for the second round is £113,154.
