## **1.0 INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 An application for a Taxi Licence was received from Mr John Warnock, 19 Firth Crescent, Gourrock on 6 October 2010.
- 1.2 Mr Warnock held Taxi Licence No.132 from 6 October 2009 until it lapsed on 30 September 2010.
- 1.3 Mr Warnock omitted to make a timeous application for his Licence to be renewed before it expired but has now made a fresh application for a Licence.

## **2.0 OBJECTIONS**

- 2.1 No objection to Mr Warnock's application was intimated by either the Chief Constable or any other party within the period of 21 days for lodging objections or representations under the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982.

## **3.0 CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATION**

- 3.1 There are no adverse comments or circumstances which would suggest that the Licence should not be renewed.
- 3.2 Following consultation with the Chief Executive, Councillors Rebecchi, Ahfeld, Brooks and McKenzie and using the procedure for the exercise of powers delegated to the Chief Executive for use between Committees, it was agreed to authorise the grant of a Taxi Licence to Mr Warnock.
