Subject: PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER - CARDWELL

ROAD, GOUROCK (WAITING RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2010

1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 Local Authorities are empowered to make Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation and Roads (Scotland) Acts 1984 and under the Council's Scheme of Administration the Head of Environmental & Commercial Services is responsible for the making, implementation and review of Traffic Management Orders and Traffic Regulation Orders.

2.0 **BACKGROUND**

- 2.1 Cardwell Road is a District Distributor Road serving traffic movements between Greenock and Gourock and onwards to Wemyss Bay. There is a high demand for onroad parking which results in inconsiderate parking especially at side road junctions. At peak time congestion occurs on Cardwell Road and this is worsened by vehicles attempting to turn into and out of the side roads.
- 2.2 An existing Traffic Regulation Order, "The Burgh of Gourock (Tarbet Street and Cardwell Road)(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1974", is in force over part of Cardwell Road and all of Tarbet Street.
- 2.3 The proposed Traffic Regulation Order will introduce No Waiting/No Loading At Any Time restrictions for a distance of approximately 10 metres at each corner of the side road junctions and at the junction of Cardwell Road and Chapel Street. It is necessary to amend the existing Traffic Regulation Order to create the No Waiting/No Loading At Any Time restrictions at the junctions of Tarbet Street and Caledonia Street.
- 2.4 The proposals have been advertised in the Greenock Telegraph and full details of the proposals have been made available for public inspection during normal office hours at the offices of the Head of Environmental & Commercial Services, the Head of Legal & Democratic Services, the Central Library and Gourock Library. A copy of the draft Order is appended hereto for Members' information.

Appendix

- 2.5 Three objections to the proposals were received but these have now been withdrawn. Accordingly, the Committee is requested to approve the Order.
- 2.6 The Committee is asked to note that, if approved, the Order may not be implemented until the making of the order has been advertised to allow any persons who so wish a period of six weeks to question the validity of the Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

3.0 **RECOMMENDATION**

3.1 That the Committee recommend to The Inverclyde Council the making of the Traffic Regulation Order – Cardwell Road, Gourock (Waiting Restrictions) Order 2010 and remit it to the Head of Environmental & Commercial Services and Head of Legal & Democratic Services to arrange for its implementation.

THE INVERCLYDE COUNCIL CARDWELL ROAD, GOUROCK (WAITING RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2011

The Inverclyde Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The Inverclyde Council Cardwell Road, Gourock (Waiting Restrictions) Order 2011" and shall come into operation on #######.
- 2. In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:

"vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads whether or not by mechanical power;

"taxi" has the same meaning as in Section 23(1) of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Scotland) Regulations 2002;

"disabled person's vehicle" means a vehicle which is displaying a disabled person's badge in the relevant position as prescribed by the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Scotland) Regulations 2002;

"Pedestrian" means a person proceeding on foot;

"Council" means The Inverclyde Council;

- 3. Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 and the plan annexed to this Order.
- 4. Save as provided in Articles 5 and 6 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 and the plan annexed to this Order.
- 5. Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 of this Order shall:-
 - (a) prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of the road referred to in those Articles
 - for so long as may be necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle or to load thereon or unload therefrom his personal luggage;
 - (ii) for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in

connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of the roads so referred to, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of the roads, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;

- (iii) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties and in particular, but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with police, fire brigade and ambulance purposes;
- (iv) if the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident;
- (v) if the vehicle is in the service of or employed by the Post Office and is waiting in any of the lengths of the roads while postal packets addressed to premises adjacent thereto are being unloaded from the vehicle or having been unloaded therefrom are being delivered or while postal packets are being collected from premises or posting boxes adjacent thereto;
- (vi) for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle while the vehicle is standing at the kerb and is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture from one office or dwellinghouse to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
- (vii) to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with funeral operations.
- (b) Apply to a licensed taxi waiting in a taxi stance during any period for which that stance has been designated by the Council under the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982.
- 6. (a) Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall apply to any disabled person's vehicle which is not causing an obstruction and which displays a disabled person's badge.
 - (b) Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in the lengths of roads referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or merchandise or loading or unloading the vehicle at premises adjoining that road provided that:-
 - (i) no vehicle engaged in delivering or collecting goods or merchandise or being loaded or unloaded shall wait for a longer period than 30 minutes in the same place and no such vehicle shall wait for a longer period than 10 minutes in the same place without goods being loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle;
 - (ii) notwithstanding anything in paragraph (a) of this Article the driver waiting for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or

merchandise or loading or unloading the vehicle shall move the same on the instruction of a police officer in uniform whenever such moving may be reasonably necessary for the purpose of preventing an obstruction.


