#### 1.0 **PURPOSE**

1.1 Local Authorities are empowered to make Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation and Roads (Scotland) Acts 1984 and under the Council's Scheme of Administration the Head of Environmental & Commercial Services is responsible for the making, implementation and review of Traffic Management Orders and Traffic Regulation Orders.

#### 2.0 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 McCallum Crescent is a local residential road which links Binnie Street and Broomberry Drive in central Gourock. There is a high demand for on-road parking in this area which results in blocking of sightlines on the exit from McCallum Crescent into Binnie Street. As a result of complaints received and due to the existing road layout and visibility considerations, it is proposed that the traffic flow is restricted to one way from Binnie Street to Broomberry Drive, i.e. generally Southwards.
- 2.2 There are no Traffic Regulation Orders in force in McCallum Crescent.
- 2.3 The proposed Traffic Regulation Order will introduce One Way Only restrictions in McCallum Crescent, Gourock.
- 2.4 The proposals have been advertised in the Greenock Telegraph and full details of the proposals have been made available for public inspection during normal office hours at the offices of the Head of Environmental & Commercial Services, the Head of Legal & Democratic Services, the Central Library and Gourock Library. A copy of the draft Order is appended hereto for Members' information.

- 2.5 No objections to the proposals have been received and, accordingly, the Committee is requested to approve the Order.
- 2.6 The Committee is asked to note that, if approved, the Order may not be implemented until the making of the order has been advertised to allow any persons who so wish a period of six weeks to question the validity of the Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

#### 3.0 **RECOMMENDATION**

3.1 That the Committee recommend to The Inverclyde Council the making of the Traffic Regulation Order – McCallum Crescent, Gourock (One Way Only) Order 2010 and remit it to the Head of Environmental & Commercial Services and Head of Legal & Democratic Services to arrange for its implementation.

#### MCCALLUM CRESCENT, GOUROCK (ONE WAY ONLY) ORDER 2011

The Inverclyde Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 1(1), 2(1) and 2(2) and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

- 2. In this Order the following expression has the meaning hereby assigned to it:

"vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads whether or not by mechanical power.

3. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order otherwise than in the direction specified in Column 2 of the said Schedule.
