Subject: Fairer Scotland Fund - Update

### 1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of this report is to update Committee on the implementation and outcomes of the former Fairer Scotland Fund activities.

### 2.0 SUMMARY

- 2.1 A total of £12.595 million (£6.47m in 2008-09 and £6.12m in 2009-10) was allocated by the Inverclyde Alliance to 43 contractors across the 4 priority themes of the SOA, namely Alcohol and Drugs, Health Inequalities, Employability and Community Engagement.
- 2.2 At its meeting on 21<sup>st</sup> December 2009, the Inverclyde Alliance Board endorsed, the Council's decision to allocate an additional £4.78m of funding to 36 projects previously funded through the Fairer Scotland Fund, for the one year period to March 2011.
- 2.3 The spend on this programme during the period 2008-2011 has been a total of £17.37million. Inverclyde Council anticipate a declared underspend on this activity of less than £200,000. or 1.1% of the overall budget.
- 2.4 Programme Monitoring Support Unit staff are preparing a final report to Inverclyde Council and Scottish Government on the outcome of the programme and the impact on the local community, indications are positive and the robust monitoring framework that was put in place has allowed accurate evidence to be collected on the effectiveness of project activity (Appendix 2).
- 2.5 Funding for this activity has not been ringfenced since April 2010, nevertheless, Inverclyde Council has demonstrated further strong commitment to addressing economic and social inequalities by making an additional £4.1m available in the financial year 2011-2012.
- 2.6 The design and delivery of the Inverclyde Future Jobs Fund programme has been highlighted as good practice across Scotland with other Local Authorities now looking to implement a similar model for the commissioning of services.
- 2.7 Staff have recently commenced the procurement of additional services, all packages have been placed on the national portal <a href="www.publiccontractsscotland.gov.uk">www.publiccontractsscotland.gov.uk</a>
  Employability £2.5million (incorporates additional European funding)
  Community Engagment £990,000.
  Alcohol and Drugs £500,000
  Health Inequalities £300,000.

### 4.0 BACKGROUND

- 4.1 A total of £12.595 million (£6.47m in 2008-09 and £6.12m in 2009-10) was allocated by the Inverclyde Alliance to 43 contractors across the 4 priority themes of the SOA, namely Alcohol and Drugs, Health Inequalities, Employability and Community Engagement. An additional £4.8million was awarded by Inverclyde Council in 2010-2011. These contractors work with clients who have multiple barriers to progression to employment or further education/training, clients with addictions and engaging all of the community to participate within society. Their expertise in the needs of their clients and the partnership working evident across the FSF network, has been demonstrated across all themes, with a high percentage of positive outcomes being recorded.
- 4.2 The Funding during this period was used as match to attract additional European Funding as follows-

£1,584, 470.00 European Social Fund (ESF) 2008/11 £329,848.00 European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) 2008/11

This levered in funding contributes to the overall package of employability services, enabling Inverciyed to devote additional resources to training, development and job brokerage.

4.3 Inverclyde Council submitted additional European funding bids for the period 2011-2013, as follows

2 year ESF P5 award = £821,532 (approved)

2 year ERDF P3 REQUEST = £229,502 (pending decision)

4.4 A further report will be presented to Committee in due course providing Members with the outturn figures highlighting the outputs for the full year.
