## **1.0 PURPOSE**

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to advise of the resignation of Councillor McKenzie from the Clyde Valley Learning & Development Joint Committee and to request the Council to appoint a Member to serve in his place.
- 1.2 Councillor McKenzie's substitute on the Joint Committee is currently Councillor Dorrian.

## **2.0 BACKGROUND**

- 2.1 The Clyde Valley Learning & Development Joint Committee is responsible for governing the partnership of the 8 local authorities located in West Central Scotland which was established in 2007 to explore the opportunities for improvement through joint working and shared delivery of learning and development.
- 2.2 The Joint Committee comprises an Elected Member from each of the participating authorities and is responsible for ensuring the project is delivered through the achievement of Best Value for the participating Councils. It also monitors the project's progress against targets and milestones and ensures financial probity in all aspects of the project's business.
- 2.3 Meetings of the Joint Committee are held 4 times per year at the headquarters of South Lanarkshire Council, which is the lead authority.

## **3.0 RECOMMENDATION**

- 3.1 The Council is asked to appoint a representative to service on the Clyde Valley Learning & Development Joint Committee following the resignation of Councillor McKenzie and to make adjustments to the arrangements for a substitute if required.
