INTRODUCTION

In September 2011 planning permission was refused for the installation of a temporary 50M anemometer mast at Priestside Farm, Auchentiber Road, Kilmacolm. Planning permission was refused for the following reason:

Associated groundworks to install the anchors for the mast will damage sphagnum and peat resources, thereby undermining the Dwarf Shrub Heath and Mire Habitats on site to the detriment of the Devol Road SINC and contrary to Invercive Local Plan Policy HR1.

NOTIFICATION OF APPEAL

Notification has been received that an appeal against the refusal of planning permission application has been lodged with the Scottish Government. The appeal is to be considered by written submissions.


