1.0 PURPOSE

- 1.1 The purpose of this paper is to request a decision from the Education & Lifelong Learning Committee on a name for the new school following the amalgamation of Lilybank School and Glenburn School in June 2013.

2.0 SUMMARY

- 2.1 Lilybank School and Glenburn School will amalgamate in June 2013 on completion of the new Shared Campus in Port Glasgow.
- 2.2 Both school communities have been working together and have consulted the wider parent body, staff and pupils of both schools regarding the name of the amalgamated school.
- 2.3 A subsequent ballot was held and the results are listed below:
