Chief Executive to accept the lowest tender for Greenock Sports Centre Refurbishment

1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 To advise of the use of powers delegated to the Chief Executive to accept the lowest acceptable tender for Greenock Sports Centre Refurbishment

2.0 SUMMARY

2.1 The Environment and Regeneration Capital Programme includes budget provision of £600,000 for refurbishment of the Nelson St Sports Centre. The January 2011 Regeneration Committee approved this project. Tenders have now been received and the total cost of the project including allowances for professional fees, direct works and other charges is £700,000. The balance is being funded from the Property Assets Allocation 2012/13. The use of powers delegated to the Chief Executive is required as the tender is in excess of £250,000.

3.0 RECOMMENDATION

3.1 That the granting of delegated authority to the Head of Legal and Democratic Services to accept the lowest tender received, that by WH Kirkwood Ltd in the corrected amount of £529,940.07 is noted.

4.0 BACKGROUND

4.1 The project comprises the refurbishment of the Sports Centre located in Nelson St Greenock including asbestos removal and backlog maintenance works including DDA, fire risk, water quality and electrical safety works.

5.0 PROPOSALS

5.1 It is proposed to accept the lowest tender received, that by WH Kirkwood Ltd in the corrected amount of £529,940.07.

6.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

6.1 The total cost of the project, including allowances for professional fees, direct works and other charges is £700,000. The allocated Capital allowance for the project is £600,000 plus £100,000 funded from Property Assets Capital Budgets 2012/13.
