Subject:	PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER – THE INVERCLYDE VARIOUS LOCATIONS INVERCLYDE (NO STOPPING) ORDER 2012

1.0 **PURPOSE**

1.1 Local Authorities are empowered to make Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation and Roads (Scotland) Acts 1984 and under the Council's Scheme of Administration the Head of Environmental & Commercial Services is responsible for the making, implementation and review of Traffic Management Orders and Traffic Regulation Orders.

2.0 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 There is a continuing problem with traffic congestion and inappropriate parking at school entrances during the "school run". Yellow zig-zag "School Keep Clear" markings have been placed at locations outside schools but they are advisory only and cannot be enforced by Strathclyde Police. Following discussions with Strathclyde Police and Education Services it is proposed to promote a Traffic Regulation Order which will prohibit stopping on these markings and permit Strathclyde Police to enforce the restrictions.
- 2.2 There are no Traffic Regulation Orders in force at any of the locations referred to.
- 2.3 The proposed Traffic Regulation Order will introduce No Stopping between 8.00am and 5.00pm Monday to Friday outside 12 schools in Inverclyde.
- 2.4 The proposals have been advertised in the Greenock Telegraph and full details of the Appendix proposals have been made available for public inspection during normal office hours at the offices of the Head of Environmental & Commercial Services, the Head of Legal & Democratic Services and at all Inverclyde Libraries. A copy of the draft Order is appended hereto for Members' information.
- 2.5 No objections to the proposals have been received and, accordingly, the Committee is requested to approve the Order.
- 2.6 The Committee is asked to note that, if approved, the Order may not be implemented until the making of the Order has been advertised to allow any persons who so wish a period of six weeks to question the validity of the Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

3.0 **RECOMMENDATION**

3.1 That the Committee recommend to The Inverclyde Council the making of The Inverclyde Various Locations Inverclyde (No Stopping) Order 2012 and remit it to the Head of Environmental & Commercial Services and Head of Legal & Democratic Services to arrange for its implementation. The Inverclyde Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order.

- 2. In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:

"emergency service vehicle" means a vehicle being used by Police, Fire and Rescue Services, Ambulance Services or a Civil Defence Organisation for the purpose of saving life or extinguishing fire or meeting any other like emergency;

"specified length of road" means a length of road specified in the Schedule to this order;

"vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads whether or not by mechanical power;

"Council" means The Inverclyde Council;

- 3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to stop or wait between 8.00am and 5.00pm Monday to Friday in any of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule and plan annexed to this Order.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall:
 - (a) Prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to stop or wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in that Article:-
 - (i) if the vehicle is an emergency services vehicle; or
 - (ii) if the vehicle is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond the driver's control or which has to be stopped in order to avoid injury or damage to persons or property
