Subject:	The Naming of the New Shared Campus in Port Glasgow	

## 1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of this paper is to seek approval from Committee members for the proposed name for the new Shared Campus in Port Glasgow which is scheduled to open by October 2013.

## 2.0 SUMMARY

- 2.1 St Stephen's High School and Port Glasgow High School will move into a new purposebuilt multi-million pound campus on or before October 2013 which has been built on the former site of Port Glasgow High School. This new shared campus will also house the new ASN school – Craigmarloch School – formed by the amalgamation of Glenburn and Lilybank schools.
- 2.2 The Port Glasgow Shared Campus Working Group has met regularly throughout the planning and development stages of the new shared campus. Its membership includes elected members, the Head Teachers of the schools who will operate within the new shared campus, representatives from the schools' Parent Councils, Church representatives, teacher union representatives, members of the School Estate and senior officers from Education Services.
- 2.3 The Shared Campus Working Group proposed Port Glasgow Community Campus as the name for the new Shared Campus. Shared Campus Working Group members were asked to report back to their various groups as part of a consultation exercise. Head Teachers confirmed that Parent Councils had been consulted and supported the proposed name.

## 3.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

3.1 The Education and Communities Committee is asked to approve the naming of the new shared campus as 'Port Glasgow Community Campus'.
