Subject: PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER - GATESIDE

ROAD, KILMACOLM (WEIGHT RESTRICTION REVOCATION)

ORDER 2013

1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 Local Authorities are empowered to make Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation and Roads (Scotland) Acts 1984 and under the Council's Scheme of Administration the Head of Environmental & Commercial Services is responsible for the making, implementation and review of Traffic Management Orders and Traffic Regulation Orders.

2.0 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 Gateside Bridge is situated 225 metres south of the junction of Gateside Road and the B788 near Kilmacolm and carries the unclassified Gateside Road over the Burnbank Water.
- 2.2 The existing Traffic Regulation Order in force is "The Inverclyde Council Gateside Bridge, Kilmacolm (13 Tonne Weight Restriction) Order 2000".
- 2.3 The proposed Traffic Regulation Order will revoke the existing 13 Tonne weight restriction as the bridge has been upgraded and the weight restriction is no longer necessary.
- 2.4 The proposals have been advertised in the Greenock Telegraph and Paisley Express. Full details of the proposals have been made available for public inspection during normal office hours at the offices of the Head of Environmental & Commercial Services, the Head of Legal & Democratic Services, Central Library and Kilmacolm Library. A copy of the draft Order is appended hereto for Members' information.

- 2.5 No objections to the proposals have been received and, accordingly, the Committee is requested to approve the Order.
- 2.6 The Committee is asked to note that, if approved, the Order may not be implemented until the making of the Order has been advertised to allow any persons who so wish a period of six weeks to question the validity of the Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

3.0 RECOMMENDATION

3.1 That the Committee recommend to The Inverclyde Council the making of the Gateside Road, Kilmacolm (Weight Restriction Revocation) Order 2013 and remit it to the Head of Environmental & Commercial Services and Head of Legal & Democratic Services to arrange for its implementation.


