Subject:	The naming of the new Mearns Centre		

1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of this paper is to request a decision from the Education & Communities Committee on a name for the Mearns Centre following the new build at the site of the old St Laurence's Primary school.

2.0 SUMMARY

- 2.1 The Mearns Centre is a joint education and social work provision for pupils with Additional Support Needs. It will move to a new location on the re-build/refurbishment of the old St Laurence's Primary school. This should be completed by April 2013.
- 2.2 The Mearns Centre management team has consulted the wider parent body, staff and pupils to consider possible names.
- 2.3 A subsequent ballot was held and the results are listed below:

•	Kilcreggan Academy	
•	Grianaig Academy (Gaelic for Greenock)	8%
•	Lomond View Academy	55%
•	Kincaid Academy	8%
•	Lochview Academy	13%
•	Wallace Academy	9%

- 2.4 The name decided upon by the Education & Communities Committee will be the name applied to the new centre. The young people clearly stated that they wanted the centre to be known as a school and showed a particular preference for the "Academy" designation.
- 2.5 It may be worth considering the name "Lomond View School" as opposed to Academy given that the centre now caters for children of both primary and secondary ages

3.0 RECOMMENDATION

3.1 Education & Communities Committee members are asked to agree that Lomond View Academy or School becomes the name for the "new" Mearns Centre.
