#### 1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of this report is to provide an update to Committee on the governance arrangements and outcomes for Ardfern

- 2.1 The Policy and Resources Committee agreed in May 2011 to introduce a process to ensure that the Council fulfils its responsibilities towards external organisations effectively.
- 2.2 During the financial year 2012 /13 there were two services which provide educational day provision on the Council's Governance list, one of which is Ardfern; the other is monitored through the CHCP
