1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of this report is to give details of applications received for consideration for funding from the Grants to Voluntary Organisations Budget in 2014-2015.

2.0 SUMMARY

- 2.1 The budget for the Grants to Voluntary Organisations Fund for 2014-2015 is £331,430. A request has been made to earmark £57,000 from the last financial year. The budget will reduce to £281,430 in 2015-2016.
- 2.2 Following a review of GTVO processes and procedures, a registration process has been introduced for all applicants. There are now 3 types of application:-
 - One off;
 - 3 year grants under £5,000; and
 - 3 year grants £5,000 and over.

Details of the grants applications received are given in Appendix A. In total 75 grant applications have been received with the total sum requested being £457,347.18 per annum. These comprise the following:-

- One off grants
- 33 applications totalling £138,218.97;
- 3 year grants under £5,000
- 25 applications totalling £68,127.54 per annum; and
- 3 year grants £5,000 and over 17 applications totalling £251,000.67 per annum.

Further information on each application is available on request and will also be available at the Committee meeting.
