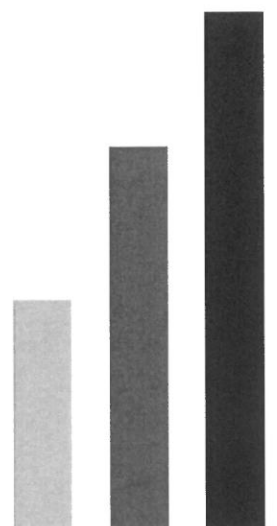

Subject:	Scottish Fire and Rescue (SFRS) Report
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1. PURPOSE OF THIS REPORT

1.1 The purpose of this report is to inform the scrutiny board of Fire and Rescue performance and activities during the 2013/2014 annual reporting period and also the first quarter (April- June) of the 2014/ 2015 reporting period.

2. PERFORMANCE- 2013/2014

2.1 A SFRS performance report is attached (Appendix A) to provide Elected Members with a Ward analysis performance report which relates to a range of Fire & Rescue operational activities within Inverclyde during the 2013/2014 reporting period.

The information provided in this report and attachment (Appendix A) continues to show reduction progress across a range of fire related performance indicators, however it also identifies those areas where further interventions are required throughout this new financial year in order to tackle those areas where operational demand is highest.

Local Senior Officer Paul Tanzilli will be happy to meet with any Elected Members who wish to discuss specific ward issues.

A summary of the report is detailed below:

- a. There were no fire fatalities during this reporting period and there have been no fatal fire incidents for the past two years.
- b. The number of non-fatal fire casualties (including precautionary check-up) has increased by 45% from 19 in 2012/13 to 35 in the 2013/2014 reporting period. This is linked to an increase in casualties from accidental dwelling fire incidents and also non domestic fire incidents.
- c. Deliberate fire raising statistics continue on a very favourable downward trend with significant reductions across most of the deliberate fire themes by comparison with this reporting period over the previous 4 years.
- d. Deliberate dwelling fires, deliberate vehicle fires, and deliberate refuse fires are all lower than in the previous 4 years.

- e. All accidental fires have increased slightly from 161 in the reporting period from 146 in the previous year. This is mainly due to an increase in accidental secondary fires which show a slight upward trend over a 4 year reporting period.
- f. Accidental dwelling fires show a slight upward trend from 2011/12, and remain a key area for improvement in the coming months and must remain a key priority for our community engagement initiatives.
- g. The SFRS attended 30 Road Traffic Collision (RTC) incidents during this reporting period compared to 20 in 2012/2013. This is despite a downward trend in the previous 4 years.
- h. Extrication was involved in 8 of the RTC incidents attended which is a 50% reduction from the previous year and the lowest in 5 reporting years, however the number of non-fatal casualties increased by 100% from 13 last year to 26 in the current reporting period
- i. Attendance at flooding incidents increased to 44 in the reporting period which is up from 38 in the previous reporting year 2012/13.
- j. False alarms are reduced to the lowest in 5 years with a 30% reduction in malicious calls from the previous year, and Alarms due to equipment failure being at the lowest level in 5 reporting years. .

3 PERFORMANCE- Q1 2014/2015

3.1 A SFRS performance report is attached (Appendix B) to provide Elected Members with a Ward analysis performance report which relates to a range of Fire & Rescue operational activities within Inverclyde during Q1 of the 2014/2015 reporting period.

A summary of the report is detailed below:

- a. There were no fire fatalities in the reporting period.
- b. The number of non-fatal fire casualties (including those who required a precautionary check-up) increased from 4 in the previous reporting period to 9 in the current period.
- c. Deliberate fire raising statistics have reduced by 46% from 242 in the previous reporting period to 131 which is also the lowest number over the 5 year period.
- d. Accidental dwelling fires have increases slightly from 23 in Q1 2013/14, to 26 in the current period.
- e. Primary fires in non-domestic buildings which include commercial and industrial buildings have shown a slight increase from 32 in 2013/14 to 39 during this reporting period and will remain a priority area for auditing by SFRS enforcement officers
- f. The SFRS attended 38 special service type incidents during this reporting period which is the lowest in comparable 5 year reporting periods. A Special Service incident is an incident attended other than a fire related incident and includes Road Traffic Collisions (RTC), Flooding, Chemical incidents and other rescues.
- g. The number of False alarms attended has increased by 26% from 154 to 207 in the current reporting period. This was due to an increase in Good intent calls, Malicious calls, and a sharp increase in False Alarms due to equipment fault. This continues to provide us with concern in

our desire to utilise SFRS resources more effectively and reduce the number of unnecessary blue light journeys which can endanger other road users.

4 PRIORITIES & INTERVENTIONS

4.1 To make our communities safer we maintain a strong commitment to active and meaningful participation in a range of Inverclyde Community Planning forums. We engage through the provision of community safety education and advice to residents, community groups and our young people. To reduce the likelihood of death or injury from fire we continue to target those individuals considered to be most at risk. This is achieved through the development of robust partner agency referral pathways and the delivery of Home Fire Safety Visits (HFSVs). The following are some of the engagement activities delivered within the Inverclyde area during the reporting periods

Some of the current interventions are detailed below:

- a. SFRS will continue to work in partnership with Community Planning partners in order to further reduce the number of fire and other emergency incidents attended in Inverclyde. Our participation at the fortnightly multi-agency tasking and coordinating (MATAC) meetings is one of the key ways in which we work with partners including Police and Community safety services to tackle fire related ASB issues including deliberate fire raising and malicious calls.
- b. Home Fire Safety Referral (HFSV) are seen as a key way of preventing accidental house fires and reducing fire related injuries by fitting smoke alarms and providing fire safety advice to occupants.

The SFRS completed 1248 HFSV within Inverclyde in 2013/14, and a further 281 HFSV have been completed in the Q1 of the current reporting year.

- c. Schools and nursery education- dedicated fire safety staff provide a range of educational visits and talks within educational establishments in order to promote fire safety to young people. The aim is to promote safety and change the culture which may lead to fewer deaths and injuries from fire in future generations.

The SFRS will be providing all nursery schools within the Inverclyde area with an Early Years fire safety education packs which can be used when appropriate by head teachers. Planning is in the final stages to launch the packs to Educational services within Inverclyde in 2014.

- d. Fire reach courses- these courses are fire led courses with multi agency participation. Inverclyde schools and community safety services make referrals for young people to attend these courses. The courses are designed to promote good citizenship and to direct young people in the right direction in a bid to drive down ASB including fire related ASB. One Fire reach course will take place in Inverclyde in October 2014.
- e. SFRS staff contributed to the Multi-agency Alcohol focused experiential event called "Wasted" which took place in the Spring of 2014. SFRS scenarios focused on the effects and contribution of alcohol in accidental dwelling fires and also at Road Traffic Collisions. This was delivered to all S2 high school pupils in Inverclyde (approximately 700 pupils)
- f. Greenock and Port Glasgow Fire Stations participated in Inverclyde Doors Open days on 13 & 14 September 2014
- g. Fire LALO is now well established in Inverclyde with a hot desk at Inverclyde Council offices in West Stewart Street Greenock, and also at the Community Safety partnership hub based in Greenock Police Station. Fire LALO attends the multi-agency partnership meetings with Police,

Community Wardens and Housing colleagues to deal with Anti-social behaviour and Operational activity matters in Inverclyde.

- h. A further 9 Cook safe courses will be delivered in the ERRI Fire Area and 3 of those courses will be delivered in Inverclyde. The courses are in the final stages of being arranged and may involve partnership input from colleagues to promote healthy eating in addition to safe cooking.
- i. RoSPA launch event- Area Manager Tanzilli joined Cllr McCabe and other partners at the recent launch of the new RoSPA Child Home Safety initiative. The initiative has been running in Inverclyde in 2013/14 and SFRS delivered HFSVs to the majority of families who were involved in the project

5. ANNUAL OPERATING PLAN 2014-2015

5.1 An Annual Operating Plan (Appendix C) has been produced to complement the Local Fire and Rescue Plan 2014/17. The plan explains the outcomes which the SFRS wants to deliver in East Renfrewshire, Renfrewshire and Inverclyde Fire Service Area, and it gives an overview of the way we will work to achieve them over the annual period 2014/15.

The Annual Operating Plan 2014/2015 is a document mainly for the use of internal stakeholders but it has been provided to Committee members for information.

6 RECOMMENDATIONS

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1. ABOUT THIS PLAN

The Local Fire and Rescue Plan 2014-2017 explains the outcomes the Scottish Fire and Rescue Service (SFRS) wants to deliver for East Renfrewshire, Renfrewshire and Inverclyde and gives an overview of the way we will work to achieve them over a three year period. Each year we will produce an annual operating plan to complement our Local Fire Plan and Strategic Plan, explaining some of the specific activities we will carry out to achieve our priorities and the performance indicators we will use to measure our success.

This Plan describes the activities and intended outcomes we will be focusing on during the financial year 2014-2015.



2. OUR WORK IN CONTEXT

The SFRS took on its full range of functions on the 1st April 2013. It replaced the eight previous fire and rescue authorities and joint fire and rescue boards.

The Fire (Scotland) Act 2005 as amended by The Police and Fire Reform (Scotland) Act 2012 provides a statutory basis for the SFRS to deliver a range of core services and functions .

The Fire and Rescue Framework for Scotland 2013 sets out Scottish Ministers priorities and objectives, building on the four pillars of public service reform as set out by the Christie Commission without having a negative impact on front line services.

Although the SFRS will contribute to all of the Governments 16 national outcomes the Framework ensures that our focus is on the contribution we can make to the following:

1. ***We live our lives free from crime, disorder and danger***
2. ***We have strong resilient and supportive communities where people take responsibility for their own actions and the ways in which they affect others.***
3. ***Our public services are high quality, continually improving, efficient and responsive to local needs.***

The priorities for the SFRS have been laid out in the Fire and Rescue Framework 2013 with the following strategic aims defined within our Strategic Plan 2013-2017:

Strategic Aim 1: ***Improved safety of our communities and staff***

Strategic Aim 2: ***More equitable access to fire and rescue services***

Strategic Aim 3: ***Improved outcomes through partnerships***

Strategic Aim 4: ***Develop a culture of continuous improvement***

3. PARTNERSHIP WORKING AND ENGAGEMENT

Sitting at the heart of our vision for the SFRS is a focus on adding real value for our communities, with tailored approaches for fire safety locally and working with our communities to explore and develop options for improved outcomes.

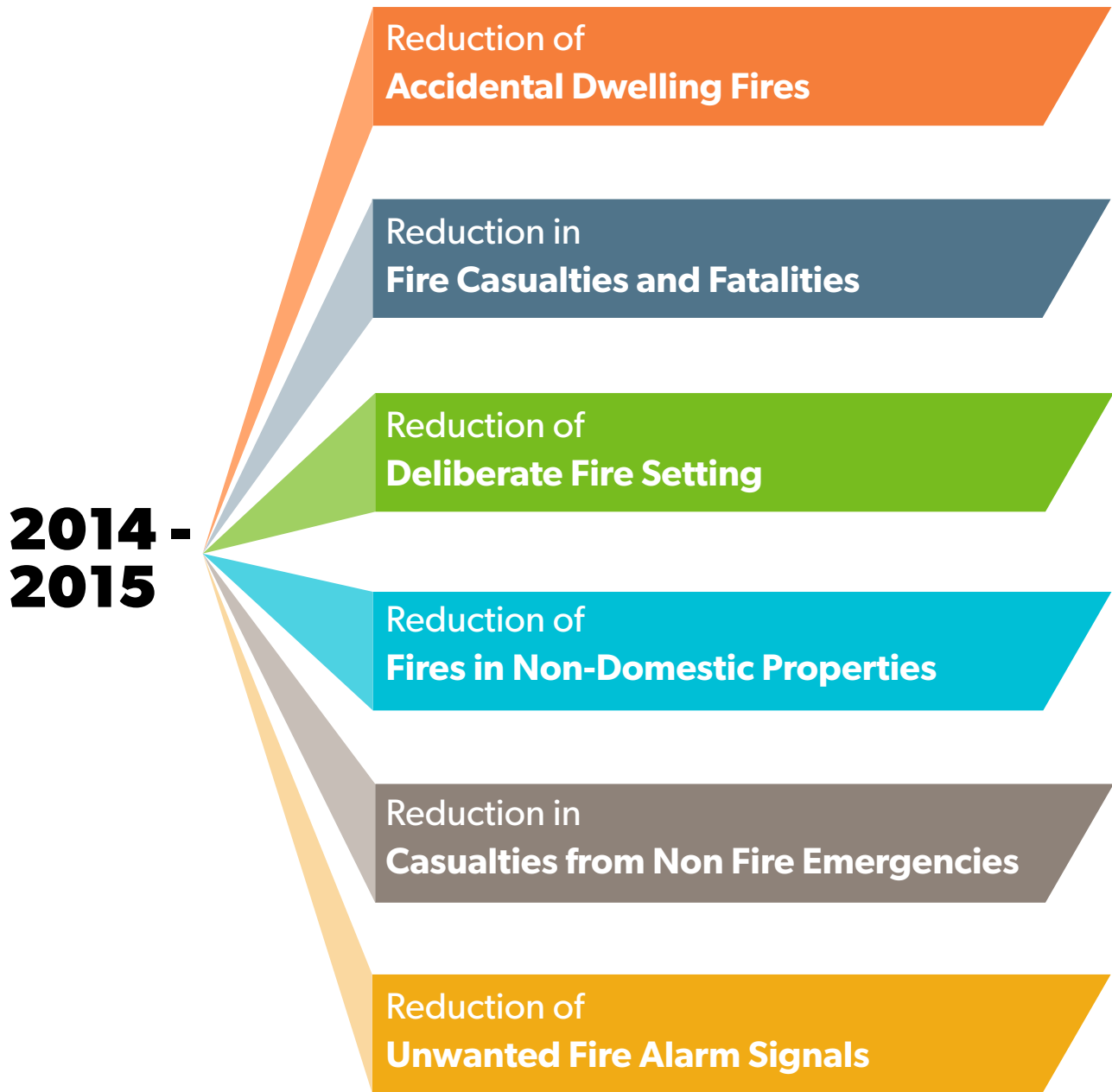
The SFRS will continue to make a significant contribution within our Council community planning structures, attending a number of strategic and thematic groups to deliver measurable outcomes .
