Thank you for your notice of the above hearing in respect of the proposed Traffic Regulation Order and our objection to one element of that in Terrace Road.

I am unable to be present or be represented on that day. However, I would appreciate if this communication is treated as my submission.

To reduce the restriction in Terrace Road would not increase the road hazard - there would still be a clear line of sight into Regent Street. I am fully aware that one or two additional spaces in Terrace Road would not resolve the current parking crisis experienced on a daily basis in and around Central Station and the Wellpark area. however surely every little bit helps?

There is no doubt in my mind that the plan for Town Centre Regeneration in Greenock urgently needs to be revisited and the traffic and road infrastructure should be high on the agenda needing attention. The lack of proper parking facilities around Greenock Central Station and the knock-on effect this has for commuters is an embarrassment for the town and should be dealt with urgently. If this is already being dealt with, then openness and transparency would be helpful to allow other residents and business users to understand just what is being done.

I still find the approach and conduct by Councillor Clocherty to be completely unsatisfactory and only hope that a more balanced perspective is taken when considering objections in the future.
